PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Thank you for contacting the American Center for Law & Justice ("ACLJ"). Our legal staff will review your request in a timely manner.

Because of the sheer volume of requests we receive monthly, we regret that we cannot respond individually to each request for assistance. **We also cannot respond individually to questions about contemporary political and legal matters in which the ACLJ and Chief Counsel Jay Sekulow are currently involved.** Our website is a good source of information and resources about the ACLJ's activities, as well as information about your rights under the First Amendment.

You will receive an individual reply if one of our attorneys determines that your request raises a matter within the scope of our legal practice. Our legal practice is limited to the following: 1) international and domestic religious liberty matters; 2) other First Amendment freedoms such as speech, and the right of assembly; and 3) specific legal issues raised by international and domestic current events.

The ACLJ does not practice in the following areas of law:

- personal injury
- corporate law
- real estate law
- family law, including divorce and custody matters
- employment law, except where constitutional rights may be involved
- criminal law, except where constitutional rights may be involved
- administrative law, including disputes with government agencies such as the Social Security Administration, except where constitutional rights may be involved

Please note that any request for assistance must be made on your own or your minor child's behalf and not on behalf of a third party adult. If you believe someone you know may have a legal matter within our area of practice, please encourage them to contact us directly.

If you do not receive an individual reply within three weeks of your request, our legal staff has determined either that your request did not raise a matter in which we can provide assistance, or your request was made on behalf of a third party. **UNLESS YOU RECEIVE A SIGNED RETAINER AGREEMENT STATING THAT THE ACLJ HAS AGREED TO ASSIST YOU AND OUTLINING THE SCOPE OF OUR REPRESENTATION, NO ATTORNEY-CLIENT RELATIONSHIP HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED AND THE ACLJ IS NOT REPRESENTING YOU ON ANY LEGAL MATTER.**
