

Dear Senior law enforcement official,

Five years ago I was arrested and charged with family violence misdemeanors. The charges have still not been prosecuted. I have read the reasoning behind the constitutional amendment and am frustrated that the very things this amendment was designed to prevent have happened to me. I have lost everything including the ability to hire an attorney to defend me. I have lost my son, my company, my good name and much more. You see, I was a successful business man with a nice house and comfortable life, but now I can't get a good job or keep a lousy job because of these charges and the constant requirement to travel to court. My attorney filed a motion for a fast and speedy trial several years ago, shortly after my arrest, but I still have not been able to resolve these charges despite my cooperation. This violation of due process has led to numerous difficulties including severe anxiety, emotional devastation, and oppressive incarceration. I hope you will do what is necessary to help me end the constant harassment and restore my good name, my son, and my quality of life which has been destroyed by this flagrant violation of my constitutional right. I do not know if this is relevant but I maintain that I did not do anything in violation of the law.

I have enclosed a copy of the motion for a fast and speed trial and feel that there are other rights of mine that have been violated. Still, this is the most obvious so I have presented it in a simple manner in the hopes of getting something done.
